Please note that your Membership Fee covers the use of our outdoor venue at the Collingwood Dock facility in Liverpool including the changing rooms, showers and toilets, the Club's polo pitches, and all Club boats and equipment stored there. We do not charge for coaching or organized Club trips, but session fees are payable to cover the cost of pool hire at Speke and Bootle for our indoor winter sessions and polo training held there. Club boats and equipment are available for use on Club trips and for competitions for a small fee as a contribution towards their wear and tear.

The current membership year is 1st April 2017 to 31st March 2018. As a concession, if you join after 31st December 2017, the membership fee will cover you until 31st March 2018.
